Mitrevski wins Macintosh award

George Mitrevski of Auburn University was among the award winners in April when the MacBeth National Conference on "Computing in the Liberal Arts" was held on the campus of Bethany College, Bethany W.Va.

Mitrevski was among the presenters to receive a MacBeth Award for excellence in the use of the Macintosh computer in the college of liberal arts classroom.

The title of his presentation in the languages and communications phase of the conference was "Russian HyperTutor: Interactive Multimedia for the Macintosh." Awards were based upon evaluations by the more than 100 conference participants.

Mitrevski's presentation was one of 32 by 42 faculty members and administrators representing 31 colleges and universities in 19 states.

The conference, planned by Bethany College in cooperation with Apple Computer, Inc., focused on five areas — writing, humanities, social sciences, education and psychology, and languages and communications.
